Troop Info

- Bring your own tents and equipment
- Bring your own food
- Every troop is required to have a minimum of 2 adults at the Camporee at all times during the weekend.
- Merit Badges and merit badge books are the responsibility of the troop

Boys Info

- All boys should carry a water bottle
- Class A uniforms required for Flag, Merit Badges and Campfire
- All boys will be assigned to merit badges even if you do not select any. The purpose of the Camporee is to participate in the merit badges
- Boys must complete prerequisites as described in registration confirmation information before May 7th. If they do not it could diminish their experience at the Camporee and they will be given a partial. – BE PREPARED
- Troops will be notified of which merit badges each boy has been assigned by the beginning of April

- All requests for 1st choice through 4th choice will be given consideration, unfortunately we cannot guarantee specific merit badges nor can we sign entire troops up for the same merit badges.
- This is an opportunity to meet and work with boys from other troops
- The Camporee is for registered Boy Scouts only.
- **There are no activities for Webelos. Since they are not Boy Scouts they can not earn merit badges so they cannot attend the Camporee**
