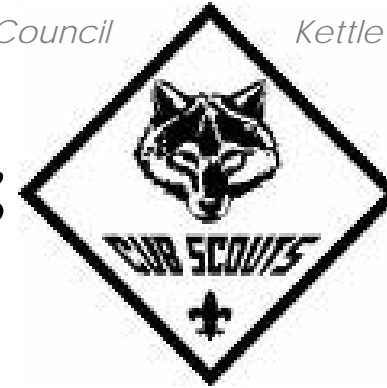
Did You Know That

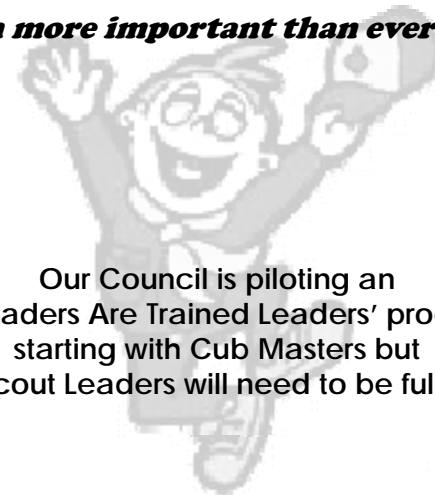

- **Youth Protection Training** (in the last 2 years)?
- **This is Scouting OR New Leader Essentials?**
- The **specific training related to your current position**
 - Tiger Cub Leader, Den Leader, Webelos Den Leader, Cub Master, Pack Committee Member, or Pack Trainer
 - For example, if you are trained as a Den Leader and are now a Cub Master, you need to take Cub Master Training in order to be trained

Every 2 Years!**
